- A reference letter from a person (preferably a current or former employer or school personnel) who knows you well and can describe your personal qualifications for this scholarship.

CRITERIA FOR GRANTING SCHOLARSHIPS:

- Applicant must be graduating with this year's graduating class from Owatonna High School, Owatonna Area Learning Center (ALC), Owatonna Christian School, Choice Technical Academy, or Pillsbury College Prep.
- Parent or guardian of applicant must be a resident of Steele County.
- Primary criteria for scholarship award will be career aptitude, work ethic, and a positive attitude.
