## NON-TRADITIONAL OR RETURNING STUDENT TECHNICAL OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Owatonna Foundation is pleased to make available \$15,000 to be used to assist individuals who will be attending **non-four year programs at technical or community colleges to prepare themselves for technical careers.** To be eligible, you must have an Owatonna mailing address or have worked at an Owatonna business for at least the past two years and have graduated from high school prior to or with the 2020 high school graduating class. Scholarship awards will range from \$500 to \$3,000 each.

### APPLICATION DEADLINE:

**October 25, 2020—spring semester award**

**June 25, 2021—fall semester award**

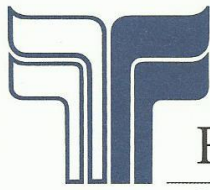
An anonymous committee will select scholarship recipients. Applicant information will be shared with the Foundation's scholarship committee. Recipients will be notified via mail.

### INFORMATION REQUESTED:

- ◆ Completed application.
- ◆ Response to essay question.
- ◆ **If you are currently enrolled at a postsecondary institution, include an official college transcript.**
- ◆ A letter from one person (preferably a current or former employer and not a family member or school personnel) who will attest to your personal qualifications and indicate why you deserve this scholarship.

### CRITERIA FOR GRANTING SCHOLARSHIPS:

- ◆ Applicant must have an Owatonna mailing address or have worked at an Owatonna business for at least the past two years.
- ◆ Applicant must be a high school graduate or possess a GED. If an applicant has already been accepted to a technical or community college program without a high school diploma or GED, he/she may apply for the scholarship.
- ◆ Applicant must have graduated from high school **prior to or with last year's graduating class.** If not a high school graduate, the class from which the applicant **should have** graduated must have been prior to or with last year's graduating class.
- ◆ First-year students and students currently enrolled in non-four year technical programs who have **at least one full year of credits** remaining are eligible for the scholarship.
- ◆ Applicant may pursue education on a full- or part-time basis but must carry a **minimum of three credits.** **Any** termination of education will result in the loss of remaining scholarship money.
- ◆ Applicant must indicate and display a strong aptitude and desire to succeed in his/her chosen career.
- ◆ Applicant should display a positive attitude and be a good citizen of his/her community.
- ◆ Financial need may be considered but will not be a major factor in choosing scholarship recipients. (No financial statement is required.)
